**Michael Tillotson** - Michael Tillotson represents persons accused of DUI all over Virginia. He is co-author of *Virginia DUI Law*, published by Thomson-Reuters. He owns a working EC/IR, and is an operator/technician on the EC/IR II. He is also a NHTSA SFST instructor.

**Felipe Plascencia**, Felipe Plascencia, has been practicing law in Southern California for 25 years. Mr. Plascencia lectures extensively on current DUI issues, and frequently trains DUI attorneys. When he was a public defender, Mr. Plascencia set the record for the most DUI cases tried and won. Local police departments and district attorneys gave Mr. Plascencia the nickname “Felipe Mad Dog Plascencia” because of his aggressive cross-examination of police officers. He was currently president of the CA DUI Lawyers Association and president of the Mexican American Bar Association PAC.

**Donald J. Bartell** - Donald Bartell’s firm is in Riverside, California and he has been in private practice for over 20 years. He is a graduate of the University of California, Berkeley and the University of Notre Dame School of Law. He is on the Board of Directors of the California Deuce Defenders and he is a frequent lecturer to lawyers from around the state on topics of DUI defense. Mr. Bartell co-authored a nationwide book on drunk driving called *Attacking and Defending Drunk Driving Tests* published by James Publishing. He is an editorial consultant for the book *California Drunk Driving Law*. Mr. Bartell is a pilot and available to handle cases at remote locations by private plane.

**The Honorable Ricardo Zwaig** – Judge Zwaig has been on the bench since 2010. Before that he was an assistant state and federal public defender. He was also in private practice before being appointed to the bench.

**Lenny Stamm** – Lenny Stamm has been in private practice for over 34 years. He is a former Dean of the National College for DUI Defense, now a Fellow, and a former President of MCDAAA. He is author of *Maryland DUI Law*, updated annually and published by Thomson-Reuters.

**Gary Bernstein** - Gary Bernstein is a former Assistant State’s Attorney for Baltimore City and has been in the private practice of criminal and drunk driving law for over 30 years. He is a Best Lawyer, Super Lawyer, and is rated “AV” by Martindale Hubbell. He is an energetic and interesting speaker and has been speaking at CLEs for many years.
