Erin Gerstenzang Atlanta, GA. Erin represents individuals charged with traffic citations along with offenses related to drugs and alcohol, including DUI throughout Georgia. Erin is a frequent lecturer on legal matters, including Georgia DUI and traffic law at national and local legal conferences about traffic offenses and the general practice of criminal defense.

Erin's work has been published in the National Association of Criminal Defense Lawyers magazine – the *Champion*.

Flem K. Whited III is a Dean, if there is one, of DUI defense in the United States. In addition to practicing DUI defense for almost 40 years, he is an author of *Drinking/Driving Litigation: Criminal and Civil* (West), the *Drinking/Driving Law Letter* (West), *Drinking/Driving Litigation: Criminal & Civil Trial Notebook* (West), and *Florida DUI Defense – Law, Tactics & Procedure* (Revere). He is a Fellow (former Dean) of the National College for DUI Defense.

Pat Maher has been practicing criminal defense with a focus on DUI/DWI law for 27 years. He has qualified as an instructor in Standardized Field Sobriety Tests (SFST) in accordance with the standards set forth by the International Association of Police Chiefs (IACP) and the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration (NHTSA). Pat is a factory trained Intox EC/IR breath test instructor and operator, and owns both the Intox EC/IR and the Alco Sensor IV (PBT) breath test devices. He is a faculty member of the National College for DUI Defense.

Jimmie Valentine, Ph.D. has B.S. degrees in both Biology and Chemistry from Centenary College of Louisiana; M.S. and Ph.D. degrees from The University of Mississippi in Medicinal Chemistry. He is a former Professor at the University of Arkansas and other schools and has directed Toxicology laboratories and had active research programs in the fields of drugs of abuse, performing and developing analytical techniques for determining drugs of abuse, and correlating levels found in humans with behavioral effects. Dr. Valentine has numerous published articles and book chapters, and has given expert testimony throughout the country.

Carrie R. Valentine, Ph.D. has a B.A. in Chemistry from the Honors College at the University of Oregon and a Ph.D. in Biochemistry from the Massachusetts Institute of Technology in 1975. Dr. Valentine has been on the faculty at the Oral Roberts University School of Medicine in Tulsa, Oklahoma and the University of Arkansas College of Medicine in Little Rock, Arkansas. She was a Research Microbiologist for the Food and Drug Administration (FDA) at the National Center for Toxicological Research (NCTR) in Jefferson, Arkansas, and now teaches online biology for Grand Canyon University and works with her husband, Dr. Jimmie Valentine on consultations and scientific writing. Recent chapters written with her husband concern both ante- and post-mortem fermentation of human specimens and the scientific status of alcohol testing. Dr. Valentine is also a licensed private pilot and regularly flies with her husband, also a pilot and certified flight instructor, throughout the country.

Paul Kent, Donald Knepper, and John Phoebus practice criminal defense and DUI in Maryland. Paul and Don are in Rockville. John is in Salisbury. Each has been racking up victories in DUI cases using novel techniques and defenses that they will share with attendees.
