### **Paul Kent**

Paul Kent practices criminal defense and DUI. He based is Rockville. He has been racking up victories in DUI cases using novel defenses that he will share with attendees.

### **Steven Hernandez**

Steven W. Hernandez a solo practitioner, who practices DUI Defense, exclusively, throughout the State of New Jersey. He is Board Certified in DUI Defense by the National College for DUI Defense (NCDD) and Certified by the New Jersey Supreme

Court as a Municipal Court Trial Attorney. He is the former Chair (2016 to 2017) of the New Jersey State Bar Municipal Court Practice Section, and is the co-author of New Jersey DUI Defense, the Law & Practice, 2016. Steven is currently representing the NCDD as Amicus in the DRE Frye challenge before the New Jersey Supreme Court, in State v. Olenowski. Steven has been a member of the NCDD since 2009, and a Sustaining Member since 2012. He is currently the Co-Chair of the NCDD, Task Force on Impaired Driving.

### **Honorable John Maloney & Jenna Davis -**

Judge Maloney is an *Associate Judge*, Montgomery County Circuit Court, 6th Judicial Circuit, since January 30, 2015. Jenna Davis is PSC Coordinator for Montgomery County's Adult Drug Court. Judge Maloney was a law clerk for Judge Darlene Perry in Prince George's County from 1988-89, Special Assistant U.S. Attorney, Office of U.S. Attorney for the District of Columbia, 2002-03, Assistant State's Attorney, Prince George's County, 1989-2007 (chief, homicide unit, 2003-07), and Deputy State's Attorney, Montgomery County, 2007-15.

### **Joe Anderson, Ph. D.**

Joseph C. Anderson, PhD is the owner of Anderson Bioscience, a biotechnology consulting company in Seattle, WA, and an Affiliate Assistant Professor of Bioengineering at the University of Washington. He has a PhD in chemical engineering and extensive training in bioengineering and physiology. His 25 years of research has primarily focused on the exchange of chemicals in the lungs and has resulted in 50 peer-reviewed publications and 3 book chapters. His area of expertise focuses on the mechanisms by which the body exchanges material and energy between the blood, tissue, and air. Additionally, he has expertise on the theory and practice of measuring a variety of chemicals in the gas phase (e.g. breath) and evaluating measurement uncertainty. Dr. Anderson has consulted on more than 950 cases and testified over 280 times in courts across the United States. His consulting services typically focus on the new paradigm of lung alcohol exchange and biologic factors affecting the measurement of alcohol in the breath and above the skin.

### **James O'Donnell, Ph.D.**

James John O'Donnell III, MS, Ph.D., is a chemist and research pharmacologist. He is an Assistant Professor at Rosalind Franklin University of Medicine and Science, where he teaches pharmacology in the Chicago Medical School and the College of Pharmacy. He received his Bachelor's Degree in Electrical Engineering and Computer Sciences from the Massachusetts Institute of Technology (MIT), a Masters Degree in Chemistry from the University of Wisconsin-Madison, and a Doctor of Philosophy in Pharmacology from Rush University in Chicago. He is a Co-Editor of O'Donnell's Drug Injury, IVth Edition, and Chief Editor of Drug Discovery and Development, Third Edition.

Dr. O'Donnell is a Principal in Pharmaconsultant Inc., wherein he consults and testifies in alcohol, drug injury, analytical toxicology (including drug testing), and other related matters.
